Care and Maintenance

Proper Maintenance is crucial to the lasting splendor of your hardwood floor investment. The surface finish of your Pioneered Wood Floor is a very easy finish to care for. The inevitable wear and tear of daily living ultimately destroys the splendor of hardwood floors. With the texture and character of the Hand Crafted Series wear only adds to the ambiance. Even the deepest of scratches can be blended into the texture with minimal effort.

Preventative Maintenance

- At each exterior door use dirt trapping methods such as walk-off mats to prevent dirt, sand and any other contaminants from getting on the floor.
- Throw rugs on the inside of the door are also helpful.
- In high spill areas, use throw rugs.
- Certain chemicals in wood oxidize in strong light, causing the wood to change color. Moving area rugs occasionally and shading large windows may prevent uneven discoloration.
- Use floor protectors under the legs of your furniture. They allow furniture to be moved easily without scuffing the floor. Some furniture may require barrel type roller casters as the ball type casters may cause damage. Grey non-marking rubber casters are your best choice. Avoid plastic casters.

Normal Cleaning

- Vacuum regularly, as often as you would vacuum carpets, a brush attachment works very well as does a vacuum broom. Sweep or use a dust mop daily or as needed.
- Wipe up spills immediately, using a dampened - not wet -cloth if necessary. Then wipe the floor dry.
- **Recommended Cleaning Methods**
 - 1) Bonakemi Swedish Hardwood Floor Cleaner:
 - 2) 1 cup of white vinegar per 1 gallon of warm water: Use only a damp mop, not wet
